Data Protection

Our interpretation of the definitions cited in the Data Protection Act 1998 denotes the school/college as the Data Controller and CEM as Data Processor. As Data Controller it is the responsibility of the school/college to provide students with sufficient information about the purpose of the assessment and ensure they are given the option to opt out if they do not wish to participate.
