Windows 8/8.1 Touch Screens will likely not function correctly with the assessment software. In addition the assessment feedback is designed to run on Microsoft Office 2007 or later. Every effort is made to allow software to run on other products/versions, but we cannot guarantee functionality will be present when using an alternative setup.
